Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Maybury Hill (C144) Woking

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of traffic calming features in Maybury Hill (C144) Woking. The road cushions and their locations are as detailed below. Each road cushion will be 75mm in height and 3.5m in length; the main ramp gradient will be 1 in 8 and the side ramp gradient will be 1 in 4.

- (a) A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 71m south of Lamp Column N13. Each cushion will be 1.9m wide;
- **(b)** A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 30.5m south of the junction of Lavender Road. Each cushion will be 1.7m wide;
- **(c)** A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 38m south of the junction of Oakfield Wood. Each cushion will be 1.7m wide;
- (d) A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 45m south of the junction of The Ridge. Each cushion will be 1.9m wide;
- **(e)** A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 24m north of the junction of Shaftesbury Road. Each cushion will be 1.9m wide;
- (f) A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 85m south of the junction of Shaftesbury Road. Each cushion will be 1.75m wide;
- (g) A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 207.5m south the junction of Shaftesbury Road. Each cushion will be 1.9m wide:
- **(h)** A pair of road cushions, the centre line of which will be situated at a point 73.5m north of the junction of Park Road. Each cushion will be 1.9m wide.
