

**The Surrey County Council  
Maybury Road (C143) Woking  
(Contra-Flow Cycle Lane) Order 2022**

On 8 February 2022, Surrey County Council made the above-named Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), which will come into force on 12 February 2022. The effect of the Order will be to (1) prohibit all vehicles, except pedal cycles, from being in the cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Notice at any time; and (2) provide that all pedal cycles proceeding in the said cycle lane shall do so in a north-easterly direction. The prohibition referred to above will not apply in relation to (a) a vehicle being used for ambulance fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; (b) anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform; (c) any person driving any mechanical road cleansing vehicle provided that such vehicle is only being used between the hours of 5.30 a. m. and 7.00 a. m. inclusive throughout the week; (d) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained within it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the date of making the Order, apply to The High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE** - That length of Maybury Road (C143) Woking, as extends from its junction with Stanley Road to its junction with Duke Street and which lies between the north-western edge of the main carriageway and a traffic sign consisting of a continuous white line indicated on the surface of the and which white line is situated at a distance of approximately 1.5 metres south-east of the north-western edge of the main carriageway of the said length of road
