## The Surrey County Council Maybury Road (C143) Woking (Contra-Flow Cycle Lane) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-named Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order will be to (1) prohibit all vehicles, except pedal cycles, from being in the cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Notice at any time; and (2) provide that all pedal cycles proceeding in the said cycle lane shall do so in a north-easterly direction. The prohibition referred to above will not apply in relation to (a) a vehicle being used for ambulance fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; (b) anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform; (c) any person driving any mechanical road cleansing vehicle provided that such vehicle is only being used between the hours of 5.30 a. m. and 7.00 a. m. inclusive throughout the week; (d) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.
