Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures In Meath Green Lane (D334) Horley

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Meath Green Lane (D334), Horley. The type of physical measures and their locations are as follows. Two abreast speed cushions, which will be 75mm high, 300cm long and 160cm wide, with ramps at 1 in 8 gradients, and will be located 25m, 90m and 150m north of the junction with Landen Park Road.
