Mill Lane Godalming (Weight Restriction)
Replacement Order 1994 (Revocation) Order 2023

On 28 February 2023 Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (4) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, made the above mentioned Order, which will come into force on 4 March 2023. The effect of which is revoke the weight restriction on goods vehicles over 7.5 tonnes in Mill Lane (D5421) Godalming from a point 100m west and north-west of the junction with Station Road for a distance of 10m north-westwards (the bridge over the Mill Stream), imposed by The Surrey County Council Mill Lane Godalming (Weight Restriction) Replacement Order 1994.

If you wish to question the validity of any the Order or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with, in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
