Newchapel Road (B2028), West Park Road (B2028)
and Eastbourne Road (A22) Newchapel
40mph Speed Limit Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-named Order, under section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to

- (a) reduce the existing maximum speed limit of 50 miles per hour to a maximum speed limit of 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified and described in the Schedule to this Notice.
- (b) carry out legal drafting amendments “Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Dormansland and Lingfield) (Restricted Roads And 40 Mph Speed Limit And 50 Mph Speed Limit) Order 1998” insofar as it affects that length of road specified in paragraph (a) of the Schedule to this Notice
- (c) carry out legal drafting amendments “The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Tandridge and Mid Sussex) (Restricted Roads 20 Mph 40 Mph And 50 Mph Speed Limits) Order 2003 (Amendment No 9) Order 2018 insofar as it affects that length of road specified in paragraph (a) of the Schedule to this Notice
- (d) carry out legal drafting amendments “The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Tandridge and Mid Sussex) (Restricted Roads 20 Mph 40 Mph And 50 Mph Speed Limits) Order 2003 (Amendment No 3) Order 2010” insofar as it affects that length of road specified in paragraph (b) of the Schedule to this Notice
- (e) carry out legal drafting amendments “The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Tandridge and Mid Sussex) (Restricted Roads 20 Mph 40 Mph And 50 Mph Speed Limits) Order 2003” insofar as it affects those lengths of road specified in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of the Schedule to this Notice

The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.

Schedule

- (a) that length of Newchapel Road (B2028) Lingfield as extends from the existing 40mph and 50mph terminal signs at a point in line with the common property boundary between the properties known as "Woodglade" and " Rustwood" to its junction at the roundabout with (B2028) West Park Road and (A22) Eastbourne Road (hereinafter referred to as "the Newchapel Roundabout")
- (b) that length of West Park Road (B2028) as extends from the existing 40mph and 50mph terminal signs at the south-west side of its junction with (X33024) Domewood to its junction at the Newchapel Roundabout
- (c) that length of Eastbourne Road (A22) Newchapel as extends from a point 81 metres north of its junction with the Newchapel Roundabout southwards to its junction at the Newchapel Roundabout
- (d) the entire length of the circulatory carriageway comprised within the Newchapel Roundabout
- (e) that length of Eastbourne Road (A22) Newchapel as extends from a point 10 metres north of the centreline of its junction with (X34064) Wembury Park northwards to its junction at the Newchapel Roundabout
