Proposed Provision of a Signal-Controlled
Pedestrian Facility (Pedex Pedestrian Crossing)
Oatlands Drive (A3050) Weybridge

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act 1984, propose to introduce a signal-controlled pedestrian facility (Pedex Crossing) on Oatlands Drive (A3050) Weybridge. The Pedex Crossing will be 3.2 metres wide, and the centreline will be located 20.4 metres south west of the prolongation of the south west kerb line of (D3872) Cedar Grove.
