Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Ockham Road South (B2039) East Horsley

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a tapered edge road table in Ockham Road South (B2039) East Horsley, the centre line of which will be situated 9.95 metres north of the common boundary between the properties known as “Llanover Cottage” and “Gable Cottage”. The dimensions will be 75 millimetres in height, 9.9 metres overall in length with a 7.5 metre flat top, and 6.2 metres in width with 1.2 metre main ramps at a 1:16 gradient and 0.225 metre side ramps at a 1:3 gradient.
