The Surrey County Council Old London Road (D2319) Epsom (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Old London Road (D2319) Epsom as extends from the point where it meets Bridleway 127 just to the south of the home straight of Epsom Racecourse to the point where it meets the same Bridleway west of the Top Car Park (also known as the 7th Furlong Car Park) on the days and at the times indicated in the Schedule to this Notice. Such prohibition will not apply in relation to: (1) Ambulance, fire brigade or police vehicles in an emergency; (2) Vehicles under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or of a sign placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Act; (3) Pedal cycles; (4) Anything done on the direction or with the permission of the Epsom and Walton Downs Conservators or the owners of Epsom Downs Racecourse; (5) Where necessary for the following operations: (a) Building industrial or demolition purposes; (b) The removal of any obstruction to traffic; (c) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road; (d) In connection with works on any sewer, gas, water, electricity or telecommunications system. Surrey County Council is satisfied that for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order run by restricting the use of those roads it is requisite that Section 3(1)(b) of the Act shall not apply in relation to this Order
