Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Old Wharf Way (D3877) Weybridge

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a physical measure to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Old Wharf Way (D3877), Weybridge, as follows. A road table In Old Wharf Way, Weybridge, extending from its junction with the extension of the northern kerb line with Bridge Road for a distance of 5m northwards, measured along the centre line of the road. The table will extend across the whole width of the carriageway and rise to a height of 75mm.
