D1006 PARTRIDGE MEAD, BANSTEAD PROPOSED SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

It is proposed to implement new Parking Restrictions on Partridge Mead, as part of a road safety scheme to improve pedestrian accessibility for children and families walking, cycling or wheeling to Warren Mead Infant and Primary School.

School Keep Clear Markings

These restrictions prevent vehicles from parking on school entrance markings between Monday to Friday (8.15am – 4.30pm)

They are intended to help manage the highway network around the school entrance and improve road safety for pedestrians.

Parking Restrictions

- (i)To extend the existing double yellow lines by 9m along the west side of Park Wood Road junction with Partridge Mead.
- (ii) Extend the existing double yellow lines by 48m along the southbound side of Partridge Mead.

These parking restrictions are to be extended to prevent vehicles parking near to the new uncontrolled crossings, thus improving sightlines and safety for pedestrians.
