Proposed Toucan Crossing in Parvis Road (A245) West Byfleet

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to install a Toucan Crossing on Parvis Road (A245) West Byfleet. The crossing will measure 4m in width, between the studs. The centre line of the crossing will be from a point 47.5m east of its junction with the centre line of Highfield Road.
