Surrey County Council
(Various Roads in Peaslake) (Rural Area Speed Limits Area 2) (20mph Speed Limits) (Amendment) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and (b) carry out legal drafting amendments to “The Surrey County Council Various Roads in Peaslake in the Parish of Shere (Restricted Roads) Order 2003” so as to revoke the existing 30mph speed limit in the entire lengths of D228 Walking Bottom and D222 Peaslake Lane, Peaslake.

The speed limits proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011. A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates, and a Statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the Council’s guidelines on the acceptance of objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be viewed:
