Surrey County Council Proposed Raised Zebra Crossing Queens Road (A317) Weybridge

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to introduce a raised Zebra Crossing in Queens Road (A317) Weybridge, the centreline of which will be located 105.4 metres south east of its junction with (X68502) North Common. The Zebra Crossing will extend 7.5 metres in width and be placed on a flat-topped raised table which will extend across the full width of the carriageway, rise to a height of 75 millimetres and measure 11.5 metres in total length, and include 2 metre ramps at a gradient of 1:26.
