

**Surrey County Council**  
**Amendments to Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions and On-Street  
Parking Places in the Borough of Reigate and Banstead**

On 3 November 2022 Surrey County Council proposed to make “**The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) Order 2018 (Amendment No. 6) Order 202-**” under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 51, 52 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), the purpose and effect of which will be to make certain amendments to the waiting and parking restrictions in the Borough of Reigate and Banstead. The Council now proposes to make further amendments to the Orders quoted in the said Notice, so as to introduce virtual (electronic) parking permits and waiver certificates, which will not necessitate their display on vehicles to which the permit or certificate applies; and make drafting amendments to the said Orders to reflect the transfer of enforcement to the County Council from the Borough Council.
