Surrey County Council
(Various Roads in Reigate) (20mph and 30mph) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 “the Act” (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to:- **(a)** impose a 20mph speed limit in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice; **(b)** impose a 30mph speed limit in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this Notice.

The speed limits proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011. A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates, and a Statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the Council’s guidelines on the acceptance of objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be viewed, from 20 February 2023:

Schedule 1 (20mph speed limit)

1. Whitehall Lane (D1298) Reigate – its entire length.

Schedule 2 (30mph speed limit)

1. Clayhall Lane (D1298) Reigate – its entire length;
2. Park Lane (D1304) Reigate – that length which extends from its junction with D1298 Clayhall Lane to a point 64m north-east of its junction with Wesley Close.
