Surrey County Council Station Road North (D7025) Egham (Prohibition of Vehicles) (No. 1) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Road North (D7025) Egham, as extends from a point 60m south-west of the ninety-degree bend in the roads south westwards for the remainder of the road, at any time. The prohibition will not apply in relation to: -

- (a) Any person requiring ingress to or egress from any premises and/or land accessible only from the length of road specified above;
- (b) Ambulance, fire brigade or police vehicles in an emergency;
- (c) Vehicles under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic, or of a sign placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Act;
- (d) Invalid carriages;
- (e) Where necessary for the following operations: -
 - (1) Building industrial or demolition purposes;
 - (2) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (3) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road:
 - (4) In connection with works on any sewer, gas, water, electricity or telecommunications system;
 - (5) In the service of a local authority or water authority;
 - (6) Vehicles operated by the Post Office for the purpose of any of their functions.
