**Surrey County Council**  
**(Stonny Croft (D2590) and Darcy Road (D2550) Ashtead) (20mph Zone) Order**  
**202-**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice, which will be signed as a 20mph zone.

The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011. A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the length of road to which the Order relates, and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the Council's guidelines on the acceptance of objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be viewed:

2. Darcy Road (D2550) Ashtead – from its junction with Stonny Croft to a point 35 metres in a north-westerly direction.
