Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Stonny Croft (D2590) Ashtead

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety in Stonny Croft (D2590) Ashtead in connection with the proposed introduction of a 20mph speed limit zone covering certain lengths of Stonny Croft and part of Darcy Road. The type of physical measures and their locations are as described below:-

- (a) 1 full width (kerb to kerb) road table, the centre point of which will be at a point 7.7m north-east of the centre line of its junction with Berry Meade. The table will measure 75mm in height, 4m in length with 1.5m ramps at a gradient of 1:20;
- (b) 1 tapered edge road table, the centre point of which will be at a point 112.7m south-west of the centre line of its junction with Bramley Way. The table will measure 75mm in height, 4m in length with 1.5m ramps at a gradient of 1:20;
- (c) 1 tapered edge road table, the centre point of which will be at a point 14.4m south-west of the centre line of the junction with Bramley Way. The table will measure 75mm in height, 4m in length with 1.5m ramps at a gradient of 1:20.
