The Surrey County Council Sunbury Lane (D3081) Walton-On-Thames (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2021

On 21 September 2021 Surrey County Council made the above named Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), which will come into force on 25 September 2021, the effect of which will be to prohibit all motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Sunbury Lane (D3081) Walton-On-Thames, as extends from a point 20 metres north-east of the access to the Walton Rowing Club Boathouse north-eastwards to the point where the carriageway meets the footpath, a distance of 126 metres. Such prohibition will not apply in relation to: (1) Ambulance, fire brigade or police vehicles in an emergency; (2) Vehicles under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or of a sign placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Act; (3) Any vehicle being used in the said length of road with the permission of the Council; (4) Invalid carriages; (5) Where necessary for the following operations: (a) Building industrial or demolition purposes; (b) The removal of any obstruction to traffic; (c) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road; (d) In connection with works on any sewer, gas, water, electricity or telecommunications system; (e) In the service of a local authority or water authority. The restriction shall also not apply to pedal cycles.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on grounds that any requirement of the act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with, in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
