

Surrey County Council
Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in The Avenue (D3517) Camberley

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in The Avenue (D3517) Camberley, namely a road table extending for a distance of 11.75 metres south-eastwards from its junction with (A30) London Road. The road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway, will measure 100mm in height and will include a ramp gradient of 1:15 (1.8 metres).
