

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING**  
**TO CONSTRUCT RAISED ROAD TABLES, SUNBURY ON THAMES**

**D6214 The Drive**  
**D6214 Napier Road**  
**D6213 Alexandra Road**  
**D6245 Scotts Avenue**

It is proposed that 75mm high raised road tables are introduced in The Drive, Napier Road, Alexandra Road and Scotts Avenue, Sunbury on Thames, where they meet the footway running along the northern side of the A308 Staines Road West.

The proposed raised tables will provide pedestrians and cyclists with a near level surface on which to cross the side roads and should also act to slow vehicle speeds.

These features form part of a wider improvement package that seeks to improve pedestrian and cycling facilities along the A308 corridor between Fordbridge Roundabout and its junction with the M3 at Sunbury Cross. The aim is to provide facilities that comply as far as possible with the LTN1/20 guidance. The proposals also align with the overall Local Cycling & Walking Improvement Project (LCWIP) for Spelthorne, which includes looking at options to tie other improvements into each end of the A308 corridor.

The scheme is being promoted jointly by Elmbridge Borough Council and Surrey County Council and has the support of Surrey Police and the County Councillor.
