

Riverview CofE Primary School Road Safety Scheme

20mph Speed Limit Proposals

Statement of Reasons

Surrey County Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph limit on the following roads detailed below:

- D2358 Riverview Road, Ewell – for its entire length (approx. 965m)
- D2220 Huntsmoor Road, Ewell – for its entire length (approx. 124m)
- D2408 Bridle Close, Ewell – for its entire length (approx 97m)
- D2410 Tealing Drive, Ewell – for its entire length (approx. 148m)
- D2333 Percival Way, Ewell – for its entire length (approx 101m)
- D2105 Curtis Road, Ewell – for its entire length (approx. 385m)
- D2158 Fairway Close, Ewell, for its entire length (approx. 75m)
- D2358 Kingston Road (Service Road 431-545) Ewell – from its junction with Tealing Drive to its junction with Riverview Road (approx 520m)
- D2164 Francis Close, Ewell – for its entire length (approx. 259m)

Reasoning

The proposed speed limit adjustment on the above roads is to encourage lower vehicle speeds and reduce the severity of collisions by lowering the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph. Local representation has suggested that a reduction in speed of traffic through the area would be beneficial in terms of promoting safer roads and is supported by the local community.

This scheme is being promoted to help improve road safety and accessibility for all road users, including pedestrians and cyclists accessing Riverview CofE Primary School.

Speed surveys were commissioned, and the results were compliant with Surrey County Council's Setting Local Speed Limits Policy for a 20mph speed limit.

Delegated approval to proceed with these proposals and the associated TRO has been received from the Highway Engagement & Commissioning Manager on 21st November 2023.
