

Extension of 20mph zone – various roads in Thames Ditton

Statement of Reasons

The proposed speed limit adjustments on the roads in Thames Ditton are to encourage lower vehicle speeds and reduce the severity of any collisions by lowering the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph. The scheme has been promoted by the locally elected member and complies with Surrey County Council's Setting local speed limits policy.

Delegated approval to proceed with these proposals and the associated TRO has been received from the Highways Engagement & Commissioning Manager.

The speed limit is proposed to be lowered on the following roads: -

- (a) Speer Road – from the junction with St Nicholas Road in a northerly direction to the junction with Summer Road.
- (b) Summer Road – from its junction with the A309 Hampton Court Way to its junction with Ferry Works and Burton Court
- (c) Warwick Road – entire length
- (d) Warwick Gardens – entire length
- (e) Aragon Avenue – entire length
- (f) Queens Road – entire length
- (g) Alexandra Road – entire length
- (h) River Bank – entire length
- (i) Riversdale Road – entire length

The roads in the proposed zone will be consolidated with those in the zone created by The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Thames Ditton) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2003, so that they can be signed as a single zone.
