

Surrey County Council
Proposed Road Table
in Victoria Place (D2423) Epsom

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce physical measure to improve road safety and reduce vehicle speeds Victoria Place (D2423) Epsom. The flat-topped road table, which will be situated at a point 8.25m from the centre point of East Street, will extend across the carriageway and will be 75mm in height, 4.5m in length and will be 8.5m wide, with a 1.5m long ramp at a gradient of 1:20.
