The Surrey County Council Various Roads in Warlingham (20 Mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2023

On 11 April 2023 Surrey County Council made the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 20 mph speed limit in the lengths of roads in Warlingham specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The speed limit impposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 and will come into force on 14 April 2023.

Schedule – (1) Farleigh Road (C217) from its junction with Limpsfield Road to a point 20 metres west of the south-west kerb line of Sunnybank; **(2)** Boxwood Way (D1347) the entire length; **(3)** Eglise Road (D133) the entire length; **(4)** Mint Walk (D1347) the entire length of the public highway.
