The Surrey County Council Waterside Drive (D3801) Walton-On-Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2022

On 30 August 2022 Surrey County Council made the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers, which will come into force on 5 September 2022. The effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit on the entire length of Waterside Drive (D3801) Walton-On-Thames, from its junction with Terrace Road to its junction with Sunbury Lane. The speed limit imposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.
