20mph zone in West Molesey

Statement of Reasons

The proposed speed limit adjustment in West Molesey is to encourage lower vehicle speeds and reduce the severity of any collisions by lowering the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph. The scheme has been promoted by the locally elected member and complies with Surrey County Council's Setting local speed limits policy.

Delegated approval to proceed with these proposals and the associated TRO has been received from the Highways Engagement & Commissioning Manager.

The speed limit is proposed to be lowered on the following roads: -

- (a) D6925 Island Farm Road (from a point 28 metres west of its junction with Approach Road to its junction with Molesey Park Road)
- (b) D6923 Approach Road (entire length)
- (c) D6923 High Street (entire length)
- (d) D6923 High Street (service road)
- (e) D6923 Yeend Close (entire length)
- (f) D6924 Cannon Way (entire length)
- (g) D6924 Dunvegan Close (entire length)
- (h) D6924 Anne Way (entire length)
- (i) D6924 Helen Close (entire length)
- (j) D6922 Priory Lane (entire length)
- (k) D6922 Ray Road (entire length)
