

**The Surrey County Council
Various Roads in West Molesey**

(Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles and Revocation) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order under sections 1 and 2 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the purpose and effect of which will be to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from entering or proceeding in the entire lengths of roads in West Molesey specified in the First Schedule and Second Schedule to this Notice. The Borough of Elmbridge (New Road, Rosemary Avenue and Weston Avenue, West Molesey) (Prohibition of Heavy Goods Vehicles) Order 1989 shall be revoked, and the roads contained in the said Order, as set out in the Second Schedule to this Notice, will be included in in the proposed Order. The prohibition will not apply in relation to certain vehicles, such as those requiring access to premises or land in or adjacent to the roads mentioned in the Schedule to this Notice, or for the purpose of loading and/or unloading, vehicles used by the emergency services or for the purposes of essential services, works and maintenance, road cleansing or refuse collection, or vehicles proceeding in accordance with directions given by Surrey Police or in the service of a local authority. The restriction shall also not apply to buses.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates, a Statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order and a copy of the Order to be revoked, may be inspected free of charge at (1) Reception, Surrey Highways, Hazel House, Merrow Lane, Guildford, Surrey, GU4 7BQ, (by appointment); and at (2) Molesey Library, The Forum, Walton Road, West Molesey, Surrey KT8 2HZ, during normal opening hours. If you wish to object to or make any other representations relating to the proposed Order (including any representations in support), you must send the grounds of your objection or representations, either (1) in writing, to the undersigned at Traffic Regulation Orders Team, Surrey County Council, Hazel House, Merrow Lane, Guildford, Surrey, GU4 7BQ or (2) by using the online form via the webpage quoted above, by **24 January 2025**.
