Various Roads in West Molesey
(Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles and Revocation) Order 202-

Roads affected - Balmoral Crescent, Windsor Avenue, Kelvinbrook, Linkfield, Mountwood, Spurfield, Monaveen Gardens, Cherimoya Gardens. The new order for will also include the adjacent and nearby roads which already have existing 7.5t weight limits on them: New Road, Rosemary Avenue, and Weston Avenue.

To include roads, Balmoral Crescent, Windsor Avenue, Kelvinbrook, Linkfield, Mountwood, Spurfield, Monaveen Gardens, and Cherimoya Gardens in the existing weight restriction TRO for New Road. This is because a large number of larger good vehicles are using Kelvinbrook to make the north/south movement between Hurst and Walton Road despite the road being unsuitable. Kelvinbrook, Balmoral Crescent, and Winsor Avenue all lead to New Road, but have no signs indicating a weight restriction at the junction with New Road. The remaining roads are all side roads of Kelvinbrook. Given the unsuitability of these roads for larger goods vehicles, and the lack of space to turn around if weight restriction terminal signs were properly installed at the junction of New Road it's been decided that including them in the weight restriction is more logical.

As part of making this order it is proposed that the existing TRO for a 7.5t weight restriction on New Road, Rosemary Avenue and Weston Avenue is revoked and these roads are included in the new TRO
