

Surrey County Council
Amendments to Waiting and Parking Restrictions
in the Borough of Waverley

On 1 December 2023 Surrey County Council (“the Council”) proposed to make various Orders under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Council now proposes to make further amendments to The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2007 (Amendment No. 14) Order 202-, so as to prohibit the waiting by vehicles in certain lengths of **(1)** Weybourne Road and Monkton Lane, Farnham, at any time; and **(2)** in certain lengths of Weybourne Road, Farnham, Monday-Friday 8am-6pm; and provide that the usual exceptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, for works on or adjoining the lengths of roads referred to in the said schedule, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme, would apply.
