Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Weybourne Road (B3007) Farnham

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Weybourne Road (B3007), Farnham, as follows: -

- (1) Two Abreast speed cushions 17.7m north of the common Property boundary of Tootsies Day Nursery and Farnham Heath End School hockey pitch; and
- (2) Two abreast speed cushions centred 1.6m north of the common property boundary of No. 5 Weybourne Road and the William Cobbett Primary School.

The cushions will be 75mm high (flat topped), 3.7m long and 1.8m wide.
