Preamble

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) to (3) and 4(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and Commencement

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Woking Road (A320) Guildford) (Amendment of Bus Lanes) (No. 1) Order 202-" and shall come into operation on 202-

Interpretation

2.

- a. Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in The County Council of Surrey Woking Road (A320) Guildford (Bus Lanes) (No. 1) Order 2002 (hereinafter called "the Order of 2002") shall have the same meaning as in that Order
- b. Any reference in this Order to any enactment means any enactment whether public general or local and including any order bye-law rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment

Amendment of the Order of 2002

- 3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Order of 2004 as amended by the Order of 2005 shall have effect as though:
 - a. in Article 2 thereof the expression "telecommunication system" and the meaning assigned thereto was deleted in its entirety
 - b. in Article 2 thereof there were added the following expressions which shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "day" means the period of time which begins with one midnight and ends with the next
 - "electronic communication apparatus" has the same meaning as in paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to the Communications Act 1984 and Sections 106 and 151 of the Communications Act 2003

- "week" means the period between midnight on Saturday night and midnight on the succeeding Saturday night"
- c. in Article 2 thereof:
 - in relation to the expression "lay-by" and the meaning currently assigned to that expression in the third and fourth lines thereof for the words and figures "Diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 (S.I. 1994 No, 1519)" there were substituted the words and figures "Diagram 1010 numbered as Item No. 10 in Part 4 of Schedule 11 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (S.I. 2016/362)"
 - in relation to the expression "first southbound bus lane" and the meaning currently assigned to that expression in the third fourth and fifth lines thereof for the words and figures "between either the eastern kerb-line of the carriageway of that length of road or a traffic sign of the type shown in Diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 (S.I. 1994 No. 1519)" there were substituted the words and figures "between either the eastern kerb-line of the carriageway of that length of road or a traffic sign of the type shown in Diagram 1010 numbered as Item No. 10 in Part 4 of Schedule 11 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (S.I. 2016/362)"
- d. in relation to the following expressions in Article 2 thereof there were substituted the following meanings in replacement for the meanings currently assigned to them:
 - "bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to The Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions 2016 (S.I. 2016/362)
 - "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/362)"
- e. In Article 4 thereof in the second line thereof for the words and figures "between 7:00am and 10:00am and between 4:00pm and 7:00pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" there were substituted the words "at any time of the day or night throughout the week"
- f. in paragraph (f) of Article 5 in the seventh line thereof for the words "telecommunication system" there were substituted the words "electronic communication apparatus"
