

Surrey County Council
Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Board School Road, North Road, Courtenay Road and Omega Road, Woking

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in the above roads, as follows: -

1. A road table at the junction of Board School Road, North Road and Courtenay Road, Woking, extending across the entire carriageway and for a distance of 7.5m into Board School Road and 6.5m into North Road and Courtenay Road, with a ramp of 1.125m (gradient 1:15), rising to a height of 100mm;
2. A road table at the junction of Courtenay Road and Omega Road, Woking, extending across the entire carriageway and for a distance of 8m into each arm of the said junction with a ramp of 1.125m (gradient 1:15), rising to a height of 100mm.
