Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Worple Road (C244) Staines-Upon-Thames

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a physical measure to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Worple Road (C244), Staines-Upon-Thames. The type of physical measure and the location is as follows. A 7.5m flat topped road table which will extend to a width of 6.4m and will be 75mm high with 1.5m ramps with 1 in 20 gradients, centred 7.1m south of the southern kerb line of Pavilion Gardens. The table will replace a set of three speed cushions in the same approximate location.
