

Libraries and Cultural Services in Surrey



Currently there are 52 libraries in Surrey, including 10 libraries that are run with a community organisation.



Most people go to only 18 of these libraries.



Some libraries are now in the same building as another service. This is very popular.



You can also borrow books online. This is also very popular.



Many people, especially vulnerable people, like to use the free computers and wi-fi at libraries.



There are many volunteers working in Surrey Libraries.

The Government is giving Surrey County Council less money to pay for services.




The Council cannot afford to carry on paying for the current library service.





Question 1.2: What effect does this principle have on you?








Question 1.5: Do you agree or disagree that libraries are best when they work with other organisations, including sharing buildings?










